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On 10 May 1842, Julius Springer founded his bookstore and publishing house in Berlin, laying the foundation for today's company. After 175 dynamic years the name Springer stands for a globally active publisher dedicated to the advancement of science, putting its authors and editors at the heart of the company's publishing activities. Springer has been at the forefront of academic and professional publishing for nearly two centuries, with increasingly new subject portfolios being added, and offices in many new locations across continents to create a truly international company today. The company has been a forerunner in digitalization of all its products and is at the cutting-edge of global discussions on publishing ethics, research sharing requirements and accessibility. It is a major open access publisher with more than 300 open access journals and a large number of open access books.



In January 2015, the announced fusion of *Springer Science+Business Media* and the majority of *Macmillan Science and Education* (including the *Nature Publishing Group*) shook the publishing sector. The merger produced *Springer Nature*, with the publishing group Georg von Holtzbrinck holding 53 percent of the market shares. Springer Nature is a new entity with unique strategic potential, combining two scientific publishers that each have more than 150-years of publishing tradition and outstanding international reputations. In the year of the merger, the newly formed company was home to 13,000 employees in more than 50 countries and generated revenues of 1.5 billion euros.
