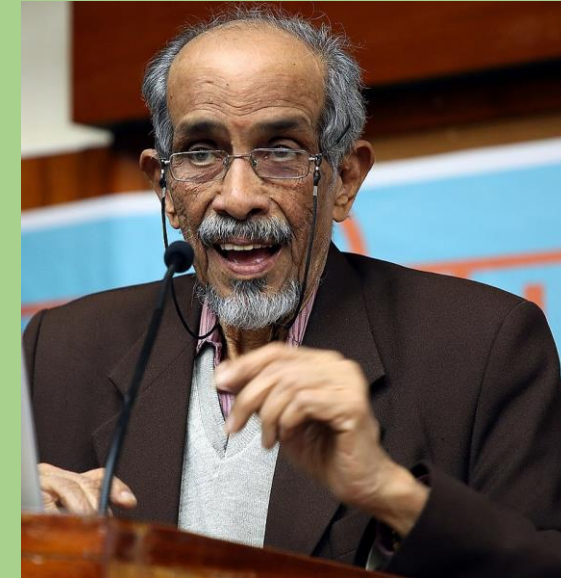

Prof. Roddam Narasimha (20 July 1933 – 14 December 2020) was a world-renowned expert in the areas of fluid dynamics and atmospheric sciences.
